

Zoe's Café Stocking Apple Cakes

Angela Logan, the Teaneck woman who recently resorted to selling apple cakes to prevent her home from going into foreclosure, is now making her treats available at Zoe's Cupcake Cafe, 740 Chestnut Ave., Teaneck.

When Zoe's managers heard that Logan was baking cakes in an effort to pay her mortgage, they offered her their kitchen. Little did they know that she had hundreds and hundreds of cake orders, and that the Hilton of Hasbrouck Heights had already offered her a corner of that kitchen. As it turns out, what Logan did need was a local pick-up spot for her cakes and that's where Zoe's came in.

Logan has offered Zoe's a portion of the proceeds as a donation. Zoe's Cupcake Cafe is a program of Zoe's Place, Inc., a non-profit organization whose primary mission is to provide a safe, supervised home and support services for homeless, pregnant teens, teen mothers, and their babies. Zoe's Place was awarded a grant from Women United in Philanthropy to launch a social enterprise (the Cupcake Cafe). A total of 100 percent of Zoe's Cupcake Cafe net proceeds support the programs, pregnant teens, teen moms, and children of Zoe's Place. The cafe also provides training and employment opportunities for the young women.
