**Bergen County** Freeholder Tomas Padilla plans to answer questions about county services Tuesday evening at the Johnson Public Library auditorium in Hackensack.

Padilla, along with officials from several county agencies and private charities, will provide information regarding foreclosures, housing and food stamps.

"We're trying to bring a lot of the services out to the people," Padilla said.  
"We're trying to do it in different parts of the county."

Padilla said the Hackensack gathering is the fourth organized by the county in recent months.

Representatives from the **United Way**, as well as officials from the county's Sheriff's Office, Housing Authority and Human Services Department are expected to attend.

Padilla said Spanish and Korean language translators will be in attendance as well.

The session is expected to begin at 6 p.m. and end at 8:30 p.m. The library is at 274 Main St.
